

COVE CREEK CLUB GOLF COURSE PLAYING PRIVILEGES AND POLICIES

Effective May 20, 2021

➤ Annual Golf Fees and Coverage

○ **Member's Household Fee:** \$75 per household. Includes the following for all residing household family members:

- Bag Tags (recorded for each individual at the office)
- Unlimited golf
- Entry in the USGA approved CCC Handicap System
- Right to bring Guests
- Member's right to acquire Non-Residing Family Member Bag Tags
- Member's right to acquire Registered Guest Bag Tags

○ **Non-Residing Family Members Bag Tag Fee:** \$50 per person for adults, \$25 for ages 12-18, no charge under 12. Only Members acquiring the Member's Household Fee may acquire these bag tags. These bag tags include the following for each non-residing family member:

- Bag Tag
- Unlimited golf privileges
- Entry into the Handicap System
- Right to bring outside guests

Non-Residing Family Members covered are: Children, Grandchildren, Parents, Grandparents, Brothers, Sisters, Sons-in Law, Daughters-in Law

○ **Registered Guest Fee:** \$125 per person. This category of bag tags and fees allows Members acquiring the Member's Household Fee to pre-pay outside guest fees for individual outside guests. This Registered Guest Fee includes the following for each guest registered:

- Registered Guest Bag Tags (different than those of the Members)
- Golf privileges subject to the following:
 - Must be accompanied by a CCC Member
 - Guests may NOT bring other guests
 - Guests are eligible for the CCC Handicap System
 - The Registered Guest's name must be submitted by the Members and will be recorded by the CCC office. That guest's bag tag is NOT transferable to other guests.

➤ **General Information**

- All Members, family members and registered guests must display a Cove Creek bag tag on their bags.
- Each year, Members must obtain annual stickers/tags from the office to renew their bag tags for all bag tags assigned to the Member's household.
- **All privately owned riding golf carts must have the owner's lot number affixed to each side of their cart with three-inch numbers that are clearly visible.**
- **All guests must sign in when they get to the 1st tee. Members do NOT need to sign in.**
- Each year the Members will be invoiced for the fees and bag tags that they currently have registered. The annual fee will be based on a 12-month period beginning with March 1st of each year.

➤ **Daily Green Fee Policy**

- For those family members and guests you do not wish to cover with the Annual Bag Tag fees stated above, you may charge green fees on a walk up basis. Those fees are outlined at the end of this document.

➤ **Guest Sign in**

- All guests must be signed in and if paying daily fees then they must be paid (or charged) before playing. Green fee rates are posted in the clubhouse. A sign-in sheet is available inside the Pro Shop and at the 1st tee.

➤ **General Course Policies**

- No more than one foursome per full golf privileged (bag tag) person. That is, **there must be at least one person with an authorized Member bag tag in each group on the course.** The Club President must approve larger groups and outings. The rental and use of the Breezhouse does not automatically include golf course privileges.
- Children 8 years old and under must be accompanied by an adult to play on the course.

➤ **Rental of Club Carts**

- We have club riding carts available for rent for golf and/or general daily or weekend use. Pull carts are also available to no charge at the clubhouse.

- Children under 14 are not allowed to operate riding carts on the course unless accompanied by an adult. The only carts allowed on the course are those carts of those who are golfing. There should be no joy riding on the course with carts.

- Riding carts may also be rented for non-golf course use, residential use. Please see pricing below for details.

➤ **Player's Responsibilities**

- Help keep your course in good shape, and request that your family and guests do the same:
 - Repair any ball marks and other marks on all greens
 - Put sand in tee, fairway and practice range divots
 - Each member's riding cart should have sand dispenser that are available through the Club. Sand for filling these dispensers is available near #2 & #11 ball wash, #5 red/white tee, and #8 tees and along side of the cart shed. Also some of the elevated tees have small sand dispensers, as does the practice range tee.
 - Pick up golf tees after hitting, particularly the plastic tees
 - Please keep all carts on cart paths around the tees and greens and keep pull carts at least 50 feet from the greens and to the side of tees.

- Remember, these few steps not only keep the course healthy but also saves us money.

 - Please obey all playing conditions signs such as:
 - COURSE CLOSED
 - CART PATHS ONLY
 - CARTS IN ROUGH ONLY
 - NO CARTS

 - **ALWAYS AVOID LOW, WET AREAS ON THE COURSE and STAY OFF OF FAIRWAYS THAT ARE ROPED OFF.**

➤ **Shoes/Spikes**

- Spike less or soft spike shoes are required.

➤ **Pace of Play**

- Slow play can spoil your game and that of others behind you. Invite faster groups to play through.
- Please exercise common sense and if it is better to tee off on a hole other than #1 to expedite play, please do so without interfering with other groups that may already be on the course.

➤ **Friday, Weekend and Holiday Play**

- All open play golfers on these days must usually try to start on #1 tee. Weekly Men's and Women's golf typically shot gun start. Open play golfers requesting to tee off concurrently with the Men's or Women's groups will be worked in with mutual cooperation. Check in with the group's leader for tee assignments.

➤ **Safety**

- Please caution children and others, as appropriate, not to stroll/play on the course. Being hit by a golf ball can cause significant injury. Watch out for lightning! If you see lightning or hear thunder, get off of the course.

➤ **Attire**

- Proper attire must be worn when playing golf:
- Shirts and shoes must be worn at all times.
- No bathing suits.
- No blue jeans, cut-off's or gym shorts.
- No halter, tube or strapless tops.
- Collared shirts for men.
- No tee, tank top or undershirts.

➤ **The Practice Area**

- Putting Green, chipping green, practice bunker and a 150-yard practice range is available in front of the clubhouse. There is no charge for range balls.
- **PLEASE DO NOT HIT BALLS OFF OF RANGE. DO NOT USE CLUBS THAT YOU CAN HIT FURTHER THAN 150 YARDS.**

➤ **The Course**

- U.S.G.A. rules apply, as modified by local rules below:
- **Out of Bounds**
 - Boundaries of golf course property, split rail fences and white stakes. Penalty: stroke and distance.
- **Water Hazards**
 - Between yellow stakes. If electing to take relief, drop back between point of entry into water and point of stroke. Penalty 1 stroke.
 - Lateral hazards between red stakes. If electing to take relief, drop within 2 club lengths of point of entry not nearer the hole. Penalty 1 stroke.
- **Drop Areas**
 - #6, 7,8,15,16,17 used under one stroke penalty

- You may elect to play the ball as it lies from hazards (USGA), but you must obtain relief and do not enter or play a shot from any marked environmental area.

➤ **Yardage Markers**

- White poles with black stripes in fairway are 150 yards, red flat markers in center of fairway are 100 yards to middle of green and various other 150-yardage markers on the side of the fairways. Distance yardage markers on tees are also to the center of the green.

➤ **Rest Rooms**

- Restrooms are located in the Clubhouse and adjacent to the exercise facility near #7/16 green at the intersection of Penny Drive and Tanner's Point Drive.

➤ **Drinking Water**

- Available at #5/14 red/white and #8/17 tees.

➤ **Lost and Found Items**

- Recent lost and found items may be found in the Clubhouse office or entrance foyer. Older items are placed on a shelf in the card shed.

➤ **USGA Approved Handicap System**

- All regular players should enter their scores into the system after play so that accurate handicaps may be maintained. The Handicap System Software used is approved for keeping approved USGA golfing handicaps.

➤ **Women's and Men's Associations**

- The Cove Creek Women's and Men's Associations have "regular" play days for their golfing members. Please contact the office to join these associations.

➤ **Tournaments and Outings**

- Tournaments and fun golfing events for the Members are scheduled throughout the year, usually on weekends. Members may schedule outside group outings on **Wednesdays** by contacting the Board. Outings and tournaments are posted on the monthly calendar in the Clubhouse and special notices for each event are also posted.
- All are encouraged to join the Men and Women's Golfing Associations and also the many golfing events throughout the season.

➤ **Pricing**

- USGA approved CCC Handicap Program included in annual bag tag fees for Members and Extended Family (see beginning of document)
- Walk Up Daily Green Fee Rate: \$25
 - Nine Hole Rate: \$15
 - Junior Rate (those < 19 years of age) half of regular rate
- Cart fees \$24 for 18 holes, \$12 for 9 holes per cart
- Cart fees, non-golfing use \$30 day, \$50 Sat-Sun (overnight)
- Outings
 - Guest Fees \$40 cart and green fee per person
 - Course Closure Fee \$100 for Outside Tournaments
