

Committee and Association Policy

The purpose of this policy is to establish guidelines to ensure a productive relationship between the Board, Committees, Associations and the Membership.

Overall Purpose and Goals Of Committees

1. The purpose of all club committees is to assist the directors in obtaining the strategic goals of the Club.
2. The Board and committee chairs will try to obtain Members whose skills and experience match the purpose of a given committee.
3. The Board and committee chairs will determine the number of members needed for a committee as appropriate for the committee's purpose.
4. The Board and committee chairs encourage participation from throughout the community and will consider all volunteers from the Membership for committees while ensuring the goals of this policy and the Bylaws are maintained.

Specific Requirements To Support The Overall Purpose and Goals of The Committees

1. Chairpersons are chosen by the Board of Directors.
2. Committee members are determined and serve by mutual agreement between the Board of Directors and the committee chairs.
3. Directors may not chair committees but may be members of committees.
4. There shall be no more than one Member from the same household on a given committee.
5. A Member may not be a member of more than three committees.

Guidelines for Cove Creek Associations and Social

1. Associations and Social Groups are not established nor governed by the Board of Directors. If, however, these Associations or Social Groups use the "Cove Creek" name and/or use the Cove Creek facilities, common areas, etc. then all Members shall be entitled to join these groups which will adhere to the overall Standards of the club.
